What is mononucleosis?

Mononucleosis (often called “mono”) is an infection caused by the Epstein-Barr virus. Signs of mono include fever, sore throat, headaches, white patches on the back of your throat, swollen glands in your neck, feeling tired and not feeling hungry.

Scoliosis

scoliosis is a lateral or sideways curve in the spine that is apparent when viewing the spine from behind. A mild degree of scoliosis is common, occurring in up to 50 per cent of the population. Scoliosis generally does not require any specific treatment. However, severe scoliosis does indeed need treatment.

Note the double negative ("never" and "not"). Also: "weren't that great" → "[were] not that great" → "not [all] that great" = mild criticism (e.g., "The dinner wasn't all that great....")
