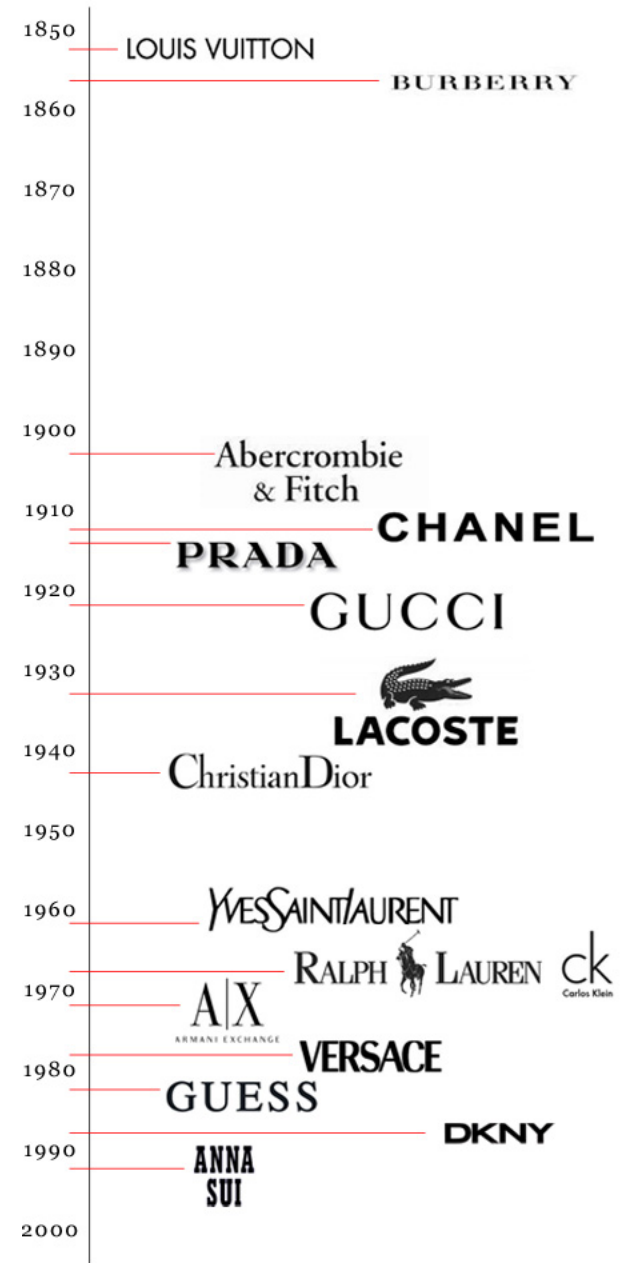

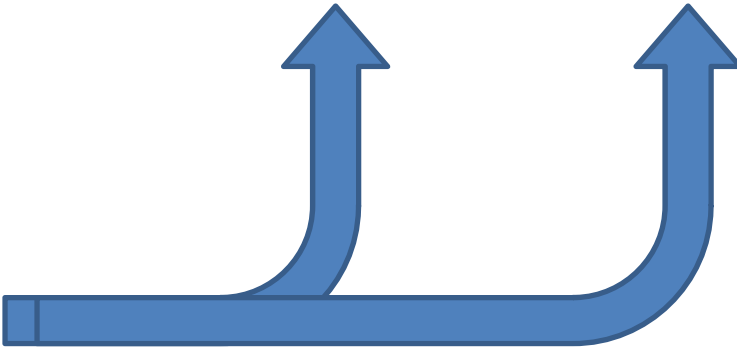

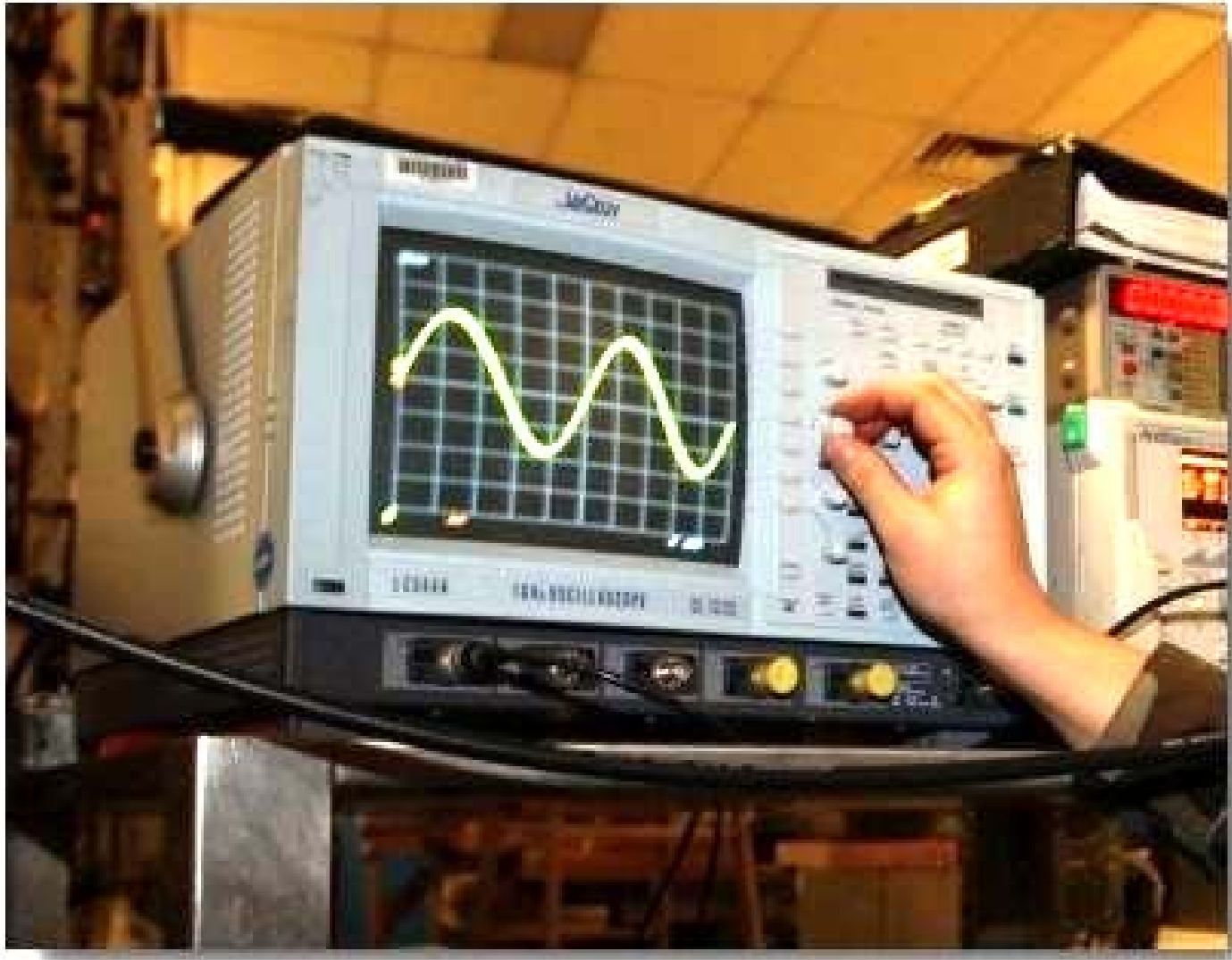

usually

often

sometimes

rarely / seldom

never

Adverbs of frequency: Answers

always

- 😊 **When I drink tea, I *always* drink green tea.**
- 😐 I *always* drink **green** tea.
- 😊 I ***never*** drink black tea.

usually

- 😊 I *usually* work out **on Wednesdays and weekends.**
- 😐 I *usually* work out.

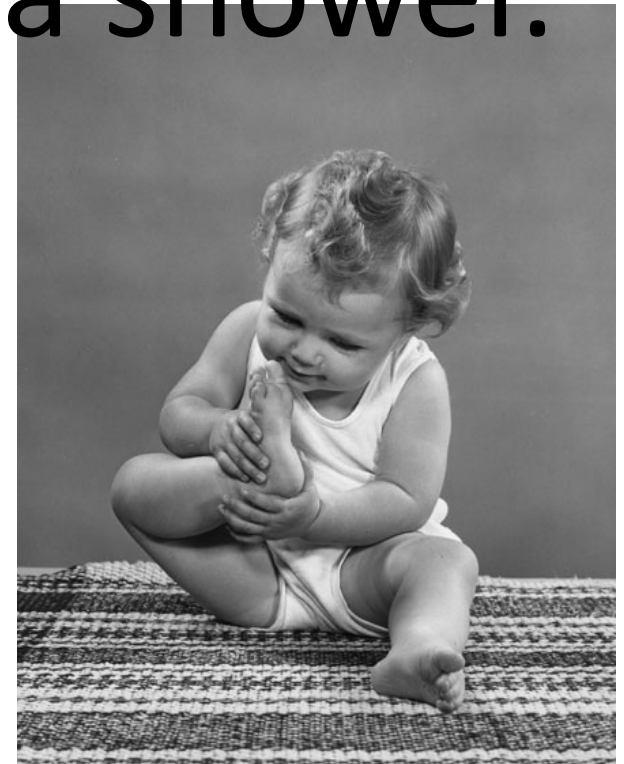
Expressions of frequency: Answers
