always usually often sometimes rarely / seldom never

Adverbs of frequency: Answers

always

- When I drink tea, I always drink green tea.
- I always drink green tea.
- © I never drink black tea.

usually

- © I usually work out on Wednesdays and weekends.

Expressions of frequency: Answers

...once day.
...twice week.
...three times month.
...n times year.
