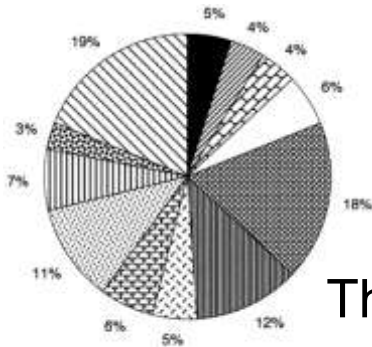




Have you ever known a pathological liar?

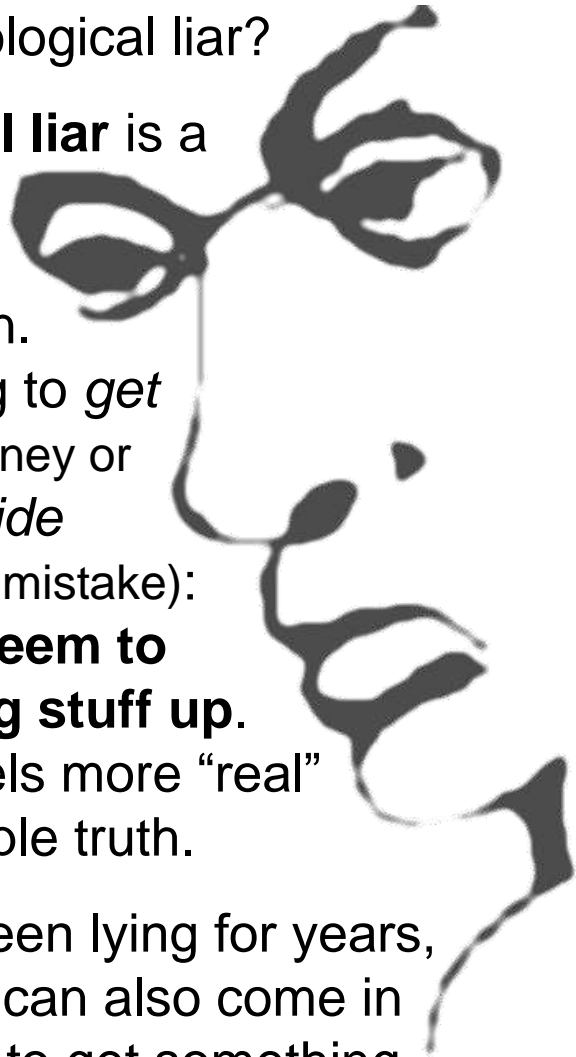
A list of plant pathologies

They just seem to enjoy making stuff up.

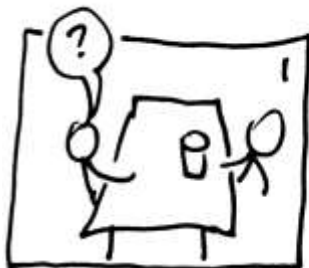
To them, it feels more "real" than just telling the simple truth.
